Year 4 <div>*Intermediate language teaching</div>	<p>Presenting myself- Je me présente</p> <p>Unit objective: To say your name, age and where you live.</p> <p>*To ask somebody their age, name, where they live and reply. *To ask somebody how they are feeling and give an appropriate response back. *To know how to count to 20.</p>	<p>In the classroom- En classe</p> <p>Unit objective: To say what you have and do not have in your pencil case.</p> <p>*To recall from memory a selection of nouns and indefinite articles for common classroom objects. *To learn how to use the negative in French. *To describe what we have and do not have in our pencil case. *To respond to simple classroom commands.</p>	<p>The weather- Quel temps fait-il?</p> <p>Unit objective: To be able to describe the weather.</p> <p>*To recognise and recall 9 weather expressions from memory. *To ask what the weather is today and give a reply. *To describe the weather in France, using a map with symbols.</p>

<p>Year 6</p> <p>*Progressive language teaching</p>	<p>At school- A l'école</p> <p>Unit objective: To discuss what subjects you like and do not like at school and give a reason why.</p> <p>*To name the subjects we study in school with the correct definite article/determiner. *To extend sentences by giving an opinion on the various school subjects and extend</p>	<p>At the Tea Room - Au salon de thé</p> <p>Unit objective: have the knowledge and skills necessary to perform a short role-play in a French tea room</p> <p>*Remember and recall a wide variety of foods, snacks, and drinks (with their indefinite article/determiner) typically served in a salon de thé. *To understand better how to change a singular noun to plural form.</p>	<p>The week-end- le weekend</p> <p>Unit objective: To describe what activities I do at the weekend with a time and an opinion.</p> <p>*To tell the time in French using quarter past, half past and quarter to. *To say and write what we do at the weekend using two or more sentences.</p>
