

THINK BEFORE YOU PARK

Illegally parked vehicles cause a potential danger to all road users. They obstruct the views of pedestrians and other vehicular traffic. This obstruction also prevents access for emergency services.

As an alternative to Police action we are asking for your cooperation, in following these guidelines in a positive effort to reduce the potential danger ultimately if future obstruction remains we will have a zero tolerance approach when dealing with this community issue.

Do not park on the pavement or grass verge

Always keep pavements clear for pedestrians

Never stop or park on zig zag lines or double yellows

Give yourself more time to park safely

Every vehicle is a potential hazard and obstruction

Remember pedestrian's safety.

Merseyside Police and its partner agencies patrol areas to ensure your safety. If vehicles are parked or found stopping illegally drivers may be issued with a fixed penalty notice, which carries a fine up to £60.
