Instrument of Government

1. Legislation and statutory guidance

Governing boards of maintained schools must have an instrument of government which sets out information about how the board is constituted. This requirement is set out in the School Governance (Constitution) (England) Regulations 2012, part 5, regulation 28.

This model is based on the Department for Education's (DfE) model instrument of government in Annex C of statutory guidance for maintained schools.

2. Instrument of government

The name of the school is: **Rice Lane Primary School and Nursery.**

The school is a: **Community Primary School.**

The name of the governing board is: **‘The Governing board of Rice Lane Primary School and Nursery’.**

The governing board shall consist of:

- a. 2 parent governors
- b. 1 LA governor
- c. 1 staff governor
- d. 1 Headteacher
- e. 9 co-opted governors

The total number of governors is:

The term of office of all categories of governor is: 4 years

This instrument of government comes into effect: 1st September 2015

This instrument was made by order of: Liverpool Local Authority on 1st September 2015
