Extra Curricular Clubs

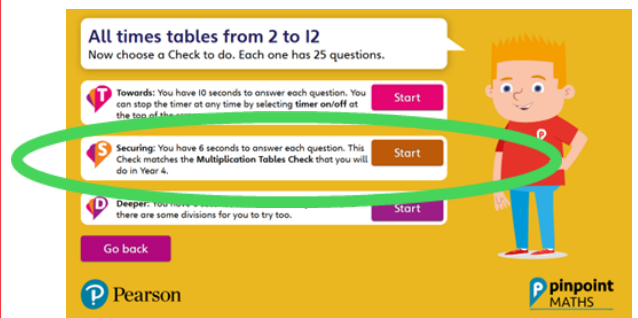

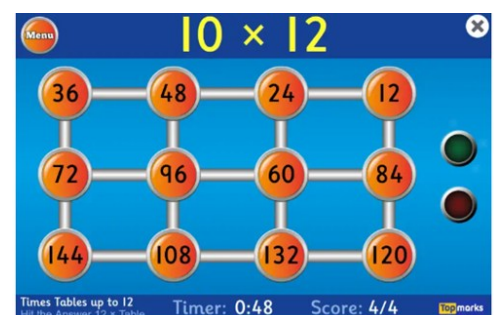
