This visit linked closely to our Science topic, Animals Including Humans, and gave the children a great opportunity to learn more about animal habitats and what they eat.

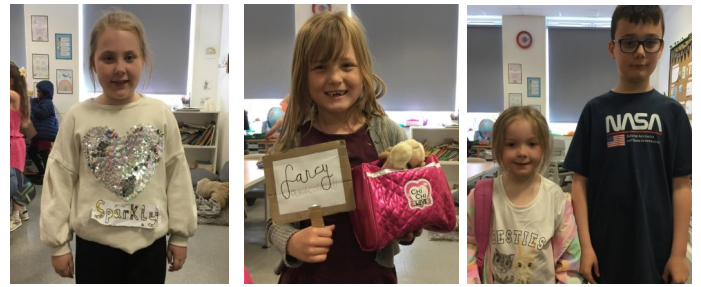
We all had a fantastic day and made some lovely memories!
